

Public information on environmental assessments of plans, programmes and projects

The service enables the public to participate in environmental procedures and studies, allowing it to consult these procedures and submit comments.

Purpose

To enable the public's participation in environmental procedures and studies, by allowing it to consult said procedures and studies and to submit comments.

The following procedures are subject to public information: Environmental Impact Assessment of ENAIRE and Aena projects and Environmental Assessment of ENAIRE planning instruments.

Environmental impact assessment of projects

The environmental impact assessment of projects is currently governed at the state level by Law 21/2013 of 9 December, on environmental assessment.

According to this Act, an environmental impact assessment allows, through public consultation and participation, anticipating, preventing and correcting possible effects, both direct and indirect, that the execution of a certain project may have on the environment by allowing the adoption of appropriate protective measures.

Environmental assessment of planning instruments

The environmental assessment of plans and programmes, as with project assessments, is currently governed by Law 21/2013 of 9 December, on environmental assessment.

The strategic environmental assessment is a prevention tool that allows environmental aspects to be integrated from the initial stages of the planning process, and it encourages public participation by allowing the results to be incorporated into the decision-making process of plans and programmes.
